The concern around closing early lays with the supervision of young people in community areas who are not adhering to covid rules, and also the fact that children have missed so much education time they need to be at school with their friends learning.

Anyway, we cannot finish yet, the children have not finished their cards and calendars and Christmas cards yet, and there is the concert to film!! We need them in school! However, we do need them in school safely so we will ask for your continued support and commitment over the next two weeks.

We are now entering into a period of time that if any person is in contact with a positive case all families in that bubble would need to isolate and this could possibly over lap with Christmas. None of us want to be in this position! So we are asking all our families now to be extremely vigilant and ensure the covid safety measures are in place at all times. Please remember that although children do not need to distance from each other staff are finding that the children are unable to social distance from the adults.
