Alternatively, you can provide a note explaining the absence or call into the office when your child returns.

If you inform the teacher at the start or end of the day, please do not be offended if they ask you to report the absence at the main office. This is due to the fact that their registers are closed down to ensure children are not accessing the teachers log in within the classroom. Office staff are able to keep registers open at all times.

Dinner money

Unfortunately, due to increasing debts from unpaid dinner money and unnecessary paperwork, we are no longer able to have flexibility on payments. If you want you child to have a dinner in school it has to be paid for on that day, just as it works in an every day cafe. You order a meal, pay for it and it is served to you.

To explain how the dinner service works The school dinner service is provided by the local authority, not the school. It is a service that parents can buy if their child is not entitled to free school meals. School collect the payments for the local authority and send the money into the local authority. It is this service who provide us with the information on food that has been ordered and not paid for. School has to pay for any outstanding debts, so this then has to come out of our school budget!

It is parents responsibility to provide food for their child. So If you want your child to have a school dinner you will need to pay for the dinner and then food will be provided. If school has not received payment, you will be contacted and asked to provide payment before we can order the food. Alternatively, you can bring a packed lunch to the school for your child, or take them home for lunch. Staff will never leave a child go hungry, but, I am certain that you would agree that we would be concerned if parents failed to provide food for their child on a regular basis!

To make payments easier for parents we are currently investing in a 'pay pal' system so that parents can pay for school meals online. We have now bought into this system and we are awaiting its installation from the company. We have considered lots of possible problems around this and hopefully we have covered all solutions too!
