You may be wondering what will happen with these children now as we don't even know if school will be back before September. Just to let you know, we have already started these discussions with Ysgol Cwm Brombil and ideas are starting to be compiled. Please put your children's minds at rest. They won't be forgotten and when we have some idea of when school returns we will ensure that they meet up with friends, see teachers, have their parties, have their visits and we will ensure that they will be well and truly looked after! What we will appreciate, when the time gets closer, is to speak with the children to see what's important for them and be able to answer any questions they may have. Not yet though, it's enough to just think of today at the moment. Today is important.

What's happening for the Easter holidays?

Child care provision for essential workers will continue to be provided. However, the LEA decided to place this provision for ALL our local schools at Ysgol Cwm Brombil. We This decision was a local authority decision. All arrangements have been made by the local authority. Children who need child care will attend this building and each school will have an allocated room. Two members of staff from each of the local schools will supervise the children at this site. We have not yet been told if this will continue after Easter.

Pupils entitled to free school meals will not be provided with food bags over the holiday but payments will go directly into parents bank accounts

> for parents to have enough money for food during this difficult time. Again, this is a decision from local authority.

Cleaning and catering

I'd like to say a massive thank you to everyone involved in the cleaning of the school and also the grab and go food bags. It took a huge amount of organisation from the the local authority right through to organising getting the bags out. On the first day only one family collected their food bag so our own school staff volunteered their own time to deliver 80 bags using their own cars! They came to the rescue yet again. The kitchen staff have worked tirelessly at the school ensuring food preparation and packaging was all adhering to the public health rules. Thank you staff! The cleaning department at the LEA have also been tremendous ensuring the building was as safe as possible for all. The staff themselves became cleaners to help out to ensure everyone was safe. It's been exhausting for all but well worth it.

A massive, massive thank you to ALL the staff at school who have worked so hard throughout the last two weeks! They have been absolutely amazing. We have had some very tricky moments but as they work so well as a team we have provided solutions for everything. We are working in a completely different way and it feels like a completely different job at the moment. Their care for your children is truly outstanding! Well done all and a big clap for 'Team Eastern'. Governors have checked in to ensure all our staff are fit and well and we have been very focused on their emotional well being also. What they are doing for the community is amazing and yet they have the same worries and concerns as we all do. They have to keep themselves and their families safe at all times too. We have had so many questions and we have tried our very best to answer them all. One thing we have learned in all this, there is no right and there is no wrong, but we make the best decisions we can for the children, their families and each other.
