Dear parent / carer,

In my last letter I explained that we were making plans for ALL pupils to be able to come into school for a period of time when we reopen. However, this morning, the Ysgol Cwm Brombil cluster group made a decision that it will be only years 1 to 6 returning over the four weeks. I know that this will be disappointing for some but the reasons that this decision was made was due to the age of the children and how to keep them safe with social distancing, and the fact they are also still developing lots of self help skills.

I know that you are anxious to know how we are organising the return. Below is the organisation that we are currently working on. However, please be aware, as I stated in the last letter, that the full plan has to be agreed by our director.

Only one third of the school population will be in school at any one time (direction from welsh government). Each Friday the school will have a thorough clean ready for the next cohort of children the following week.
