Half term Is it one week or two?

Progress

Our school focus when we reopened was to firstly check in on the children's well being. It was good to see them so happy to be back! We then looked at the children's basic skills of reading, writing and maths to see where they are as they have missed so much school. Since then, we are seeing huge amounts of progress with many of the children. Many parents have commented on the progress you see at home too and how much the children are happy to be back! Great news for everyone!

This is so positive and we do not want to see school close and we do not want any class to have to isolate as it has been in many schools within Neath Port Talbot. We can do something to prevent this! Please please please help us to prevent school or classes closing. It is easy and short term...

- Follow the Welsh government rules
- Keep a distance from those not in your household
- Ensure your children do not socialise indoors with other households
- Keep your hands clean and away from your face
- Use a face covering when in public
- Keep to the 2m distance rule.
