## Update

The start and end of day handover is proving to be successful and everyone is feeling safe. The children are entering school calmly and they are settling into class for the day's learning extremely well. The ten minute window to get children into school has proved to be successful. Happy days!

We are pleased to say that our covid positive cases in school are minimal and we have been able to avoid any spread within school. This is due to the fact that we have maintained high standards of hygiene which were put into place at the start of the pandemic. Many thanks to all staff who go over and above to ensure we keep all our families safe.

As infection rates rose we made a decision to accept only essential visitors into school and this too helps us control the spread of covid. We continue to protect our children who are extremely vulnerable due to medical conditions. Staff continue to test, pupils who are unwell are sent home for testing and we take no risks. Our reviewed risk assessment is on our school website as requested by the local authority.

## Heating in school

As you know every classroom has to be kept well ventilated to reduce risks of covid spread. The temperature outside has started to drop and will obviously impact on classroom temperatures. As we did last year, this will be monitored closely and managed in the same way. When necessary heating will be on and each class teacher will ensure that there are regular bursts of fresh air in their rooms. It is helpful if the children wear layers of clothing to keep warm and can be removed if necessary.


