As adults we all have a duty of care for the children and we cannot allow them to be photographed by strangers. The community tend to offer contributions to the school during the parade and this is very much appreciated. The money donated will be shared amongst classes for new equipment

## **Head Lice**

Please ensure that you check your child's hair regularly. You need to look for live lice that are crawling in the hair, and you also need to look for the eggs. The eggs are tiny off white eggs that cling to the strand of hair. They do not

fall out of the hair and they are hard to pull off the hair strand. If you find lice or eggs the hair MUST be treated otherwise it gets worse not better and can make children ill. It is also likely that other members of the family have them too so you will need to check. Head lice are not fussy - they like clean hair and dirty hair, children and adults so we all need to keep checking. If you want advice or help in checking and treating please ask at the school or at the pharmacy.
